DESCRIPTION

The LEGALETT air-heated foundation is surrounded by Edge Elements, which are made of expanded polystyrene.

The Edge Elements are assembled on a bed of gravel and become the form work for the concrete pour.

Edge element alignment is easily accomplished with the supplied metal channel. The metal channel provides protection for the edge during construction.



TYPICAL DIMENSIONS



The Edge Elements are typically shipped in 2,400mm (8') lengths.

The cross-section dimensions vary depending on project requirements.

TYPICAL EDGE ELEMENT FINISHING

The Edge Elements can be finished on-site, at the same time as the house exterior facade is installed.

Typical finishes are stucco, parging or a pre-mixed acrylic coating such as 'Styro Industries Flexcoat Multi Purpose Foundation Insulation Coating' or a generic equivalent.
