INTERLOCK IS NOT REQUIRED FOR MOST HOT WATER SYSTEMS THAT INCLUDE DOMESTIC WATER SUPPLY AND USE THE LEGALETT-SPECIFIED PUMP CONTROLLED BY A SUMMER/WINTER SWITCH. Refer to the <u>Hot</u> <u>Water Supply Schematic</u> and Heater & Control Specifications on the design drawing.

However, in some scenarios, such as a dedicated heat-only boiler hot water system, it may not be desirable or possible to have a boiler armed for the duration of the heating season, i.e. during times when all zones are off. Thus a signal is required from the LEGALETT units that will arm the boiler and/or turn on a circulation pump. The following are generic wiring diagrams to assist the mechanical contractor in interfacing the LEGALETT System with a boiler and/or pump, if required.
