Nova Scotia Power has now approved Legalett ([www.Legalett.ca](http://www.Legalett.ca)) for their "Time-of-Day" energy charge meters. This will allow owners of Legalett electrically heated homes, to purchase energy during off peak hours and store it in the super insulated Legalett Frost Protected Shallow Foundation (FPSF). In Nova Scotia, electricity used in peak hours can cost 15.320 cents/KWH as opposed to the preferred rate of 5.335 cents/KWH in off peak night time hours. This means a Legalett home can cost as much as 65% less to heat during day time hours under Nova Scotia Power's energy saving program. Similar savings are available anywhere when Legalett is used with this type of "Time-of-Day" energy charge meters.
