Our family residence is built on a Legalett System, which provides the comfort heat for the entire living space in our home. It is also the frost protected foundation, which did not require frost walls.

We have lived here for seven years. During that time, we have enjoyed the warm floors and the extremely comfortable living environment that the legalett System has provided. Our feet are warm, even when walking on tile with bare feet. The concrete floors are warm and dry, with no trace of mould or mildew. The interior temperature is not affected by fluctuations in the weather, but instead, remains consistently at a comfortable temperature.

The system requires very little energy to operate, partly because we are able to reduce the interior air temperature, while still maintaining an excellent comfort level. The system is not intrusive in any way of noise or drafts, nor does it require significant maintenance.
