LEGALETT.



Six homes, 1,080 sq.ft each, were built on a First Nations Reserve. Each home was built using 5" Air-Heated GEO-Slab system with a 3200 electric heating unit and two programmable thermostats that can control up to 4 zones. Legalett was chosen as they wanted to offer in-floor heat and a system that was energy efficient for these homes. Natural gas is not available on the reserve so electricity was the chosen heat source. Off peak electricity will be available on the reserve in 2010 and this was also a consideration when choosing the heating system. This GEO-Slab system enabled the customer to build on poor soils which is an issue on some parts of the reserve. The members of the Nawash First Nation Reservation


were able to install these systems themselves.
